





- Transit capital Vehicle purchases, shelter construction, technology.
- Freight Airport, seaport, or railway capacity improvements, truck movement improvements.

Cost Estimate

Examples of Participating Items – reimbursable

- All items eligible for reimbursement must be listed under Participating Items column on cost estimate sheet
- Natural infrastructure can be up to 25% for Transportation Alternatives

Examples of Non-Participating Items – not reimbursable

- Mowing
- Utility relocations
- Video inspections
- Contingency

Cost estimate must be signed by licensed engineer (P.E.)






