

Transportation Funding

Transportation funding comes from federal, state and local sources.

Federal funding is collected primarily through federal fuel taxes and truck-related taxes on tires, sales of vehicles and heavy vehicle use. Florida's funding sources are a combination of state fuel taxes, motor vehicle fees, document stamps, rental car surcharges and aviation fuel tax. Local funding sources include local gas taxes, road impact fees, an infrastructure surtax and occasionally general funds from property taxes.
