## 1.E. Comments from the Chair and Member Comments

GREGG WEISS informed attendees that the Turnpike construction schedule had changed with minimal communication to the local community.

ROB LONG announced that this was his last meeting, highlighted MPO projects, and expressed gratitude.

FRAN NACHLAS highlighted the City of Boca Raton's Safety Symposium and focus on micromobility devices.

MARIA MARINO noted that Prosperity Farms Road is closed and stated that Hood Road is the designated alternate route.

JEFF HMARA referenced the Countywide Transportation Master Plan survey results and emphasized the importance of providing choices and mobility options.

YVETTE DRUCKER shared that Boca Raton will launch a MiCa autonomous shuttle pilot in November and noted the completion of the North Park Bicycle Garden for safe bicycling education. She also reported on the City's deployment of red-light cameras and its achievement of LEED Gold status.

### 2.A. MOTION TO ENDORSE Fiscal Year (FY) 2027-2031 Draft Tentative Work Program (DTWP)

ANDREW UHLIR, Deputy Director of Programs, and Steve Braun, FDOT Secretary, provided a presentation.

JIM KURETSKI commended FDOT for roadway improvements and strong partnerships in Palm Beach County.

JEFF HMARA asked about the availability of signal mast arms and related technology.

GREGG WEISS discussed signal upgrades and connectivity between Broward and Palm Beach Counties.

YVETTE DRUCKER commented on reduced rideshare options serving Tri-Rail and encouraged riders to advocate during the upcoming legislative session.

BOBBY POWELL asked about dedicated funding, the Transportation Trust Fund, TSMO initiatives, Tri-Rail funding, and what steps the County should take in preparation for the legislative session.

ROB LONG expressed concern regarding FDOT's removal of painted intersection improvements and the potential impact on road safety.

CHRISTOPHER MCVOY raised concerns about flashing yellow signals, railroad crossing safety, and the removal of roadway art.

AIMEE KELLEY noted safety issues with the new split crosswalk on Boynton Beach Boulevard and requested FDOT provide post-construction education and outreach for nearby schools and families.

MARIA MARINO asked about the status of the Tri-Rail VA Extension feasibility study.
